Amendment to Sailing Instructions

19 Cruising Division

- 19.1 When two or more boats are entered in the cruising division, Class 3, those boats will have the option of using engine propulsion for no more than ten (10) minutes during the course of the race. Skippers are required to log the time they turn their engines on and off for review by the race committee. This provision is made only for the Class 3, Cruising Class only. Class 3 boats must sail across the start line and for 5 minutes after the starting flag before using their motor. In addition, they must not use the engine between the American Flag pole at Jack London Square and the finish line. The use of their ten minutes of motoring can otherwise be used on any part of the course.
- 19.2 The Class 3 boats will compete for their own prizes. Class 3 boats will not compete for the Ron Byrne Memorial Trophy.
